### FIRST INFORMATION

Superintendent, Medical College Hospital, Thiruvananthapuram filed a petition vide No.PW.178/2013/MCH dtd.25.06.2013 before Sub Inspector of Police, Medical College Police Station, Thiruvananthapuram with a request to register a case regarding the allegation of misappropriation of Government money related to the remittance of payward rent from KHRWS by K. Vijayan, Mulappamadathil, Kizhakkathil, Pannivizha, Anandappally, Pathanamthitta who was the formerly Lay Secretary and Treasurer of KHRWS, Medical College Hospital, Thiruvananthapuram. On receiving this petition Sri.K. Jayan, SI of Police, Medical College Police Station registered a case vide Crime No.1138/2013 on 28.06.2013 U/s 403, 409 and 420 IPC and submitted the original FIR and documents before the Hon'ble Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate Court, Thiruvananthapuram. District Police Chief, Thiruvananthapuram City forwarded a letter vide No.D1/31535/16/TC dt.07.12.2016 to Director, Vigilance & Anti-Corruption Bureau regarding the transfer of C.D file in Crime No.1138/2013 of Medical College Police Station as ordered vide Police Headquarters Order No.D9/57067/2016/PHQ dtd.05.11.2016. On the basis of this letter, Director, Vigilance & Anti-Corruption Bureau, vide letter No.E9/VC/2017/SRT)40999/16 dtd.07.02.17 issued instruction to Superintendent of Police, Vigilance & Anti-Corruption Bureau, Southern Range, Thiruvananthapuram to register a case and Superintendent of Police, Vigilance & Anti-Corruption Bureau, Southern Range, Thiruvananthapuram vide letter No. C-1030/2017/SRT dtd.18.02.2017 forwarded the C.D file to this Unit with a direction to register a case and investigate. And in compliance of the instruction, this Vigilance Case is registered at the Vigilance & Anti-Corruption Bureau, Thiruvananthapuram Unit Police Station vide. VC 3/2017/TVM U/s 13(1)(c) and (d) r/w 13(2) and Sec.403 and 409 IPC.
