### **INTRODUCTION**

The Kerala Government vide G.O. (MS) No. 525/Home dated 21..12..1964 ordered the formation of a separate Department replacing X-Branch of Police Unit as Vigilance Division under the administrative control of a Director. **The Bureau is celebrating its GOLDEN JUBILEE during 2013 - 2014.**

It was renamed as Vigilance Department vide Government letter No.5520/A1/75/Vig. dated 27..08..1975. Again vide G.O.(P) No. 15/97/Vig. dated 26..03..1997 its nomenclature was changed to Vigilance & Anti-Corruption Bureau.

It is the main anti-corruption agency of the State to deal with cases involving corruption. This Bureau conducts Investigation / Enquiries into the following allegations involving Government Servants including

those working in the Public Sector Undertakings of the State Government.

- (i) Criminal misconduct as defined in PC Act 1988.
- (ii) Dishonest or improper conduct or abuse of power.
- (iii) Gross dereliction of duty or negligence.
- (iv) Misappropriation of public funds involving more than Rs. 5,00,000/- (Rupees Five lakhs).
- (v) Amassment of wealth disproportionate to the known sources of income.
- (vi) Misuse of Public money or property.

Besides conducting Investigation into Vigilance Cases, this Bureau also conducts Vigilance Enquiries, Confidential Verifications, Surprise Checks and Quick Verifications. Vigilance Enquiries are conducted only with prior sanction of the Government. This Bureau also collects intelligence about corrupt officials and maintains dossiers on them.

## ***2. ORGANISATIONAL STRUCTURE***

The Vigilance & Anti-Corruption Bureau is headed by the Director who is of the rank of Director General of Police. The Director is assisted by one Additional Director General of Police whose designation is Scrutiny Officer. In addition to the above, a Superintendent of Police is also posted in the Directorate. Apart from assisting the Director in administrative matters, he is also the Head of the Intelligence Wing in the Headquarter.

- (i) Range Level:-** There are four Ranges, each headed by a Superintendent of Police with territorial jurisdiction, located at Thiruvananthapuram, Kottayam, Ernakulam and Kozhikode. Each Range comprises of a number of Revenue Districts.
- (ii) District Level:-** In each of the 14 Revenue Districts, there is a Vigilance Unit headed by a Deputy Superintendent of Police.
- (iii) Special Units: -** In addition to the above, there are five Special Units. These are the three Special Cells one each at Thiruvananthapuram, Ernakulam and Kozhikkode respectively and two Special Investigation Units at Thiruvananthapuram. The three Special Cells and two Special Investigation Units are headed by an Officer of the rank of Superintendents of Police.
- (iv) Research Analysis and Enforcement Wing:-** A Research Analysis and Enforcement Wing is functioning in the Directorate to assist the field Officers in technical matters connected with Enquiries/Investigations undertaken by this Bureau. The wing now consists of one Chief Engineer (Civil), on contract basis, one Assistant Executive Engineer (Civil), one Executive Engineer (Mechanical) on deputation basis and one Accounts Officer (Audit) on deputation basis.
- (v) Legal Wing:-** This Bureau has its own Legal Wing to conduct the prosecution of Cases in the four Special Courts and to

attend to the work in the two Vigilance Tribunals on behalf of the State. The legal wing consists of one Legal Adviser with Headquarters at Thiruvananthapuram and six Additional Legal Advisers at Thiruvananthapuram, Kottayam, Thrissur, and Kozhikode. The Legal Wing also furnishes legal opinion in Enquiries/Investigations undertaken by this Bureau.

**(vi) Intelligence Wing :** - An Intelligence Wing headed by Superintendent of Police (Intelligence) is functioning in the Directorate to collect, collate and analyse intelligence about corrupt officials and to maintain dossiers on them.

In each Range, the Superintendent of Police Range is entrusted with the work of Intelligence also. Under them, one Sub Inspector of Police /Assistant Sub Inspector of Police in each Unit is nominated as Sub Inspector of Police /Assistant Sub Inspector of Police (Intelligence) assisted by 1 Head Constable and 1 Police Constable. This forms Range Intelligence staff. They select contacts and collect information. The Range Superintendents of Police will forward source reports and anonymous petitions etc. received by them to Superintendent of Police (Intelligence), Vigilance & Anti-Corruption Bureau Directorate from where further action is initiated according to merits.

### **3. STAFF PATTERN**

The Executive Staff of this Bureau are drawn from Police Department. The Ministerial Staff are appointed through Kerala Public Service Commission. Additional Legal Advisers are appointed by the State from practicing Advocates. The Technical Staff like Engineers and Accounts Officers are appointed on deputation from State/Central Government.

The organizational chart is given in Appendix I - A and I - B. The details of Officers who held different position in Vigilance and Anti-Corruption Bureau during the year 2014-2015 are given in Appendix II. A statement showing the sanctioned strength, existing strength and vacancy of the staff as on 31.03.2015 is given in Appendix III.

### **4. ENQUIRIES AND INVESTIGATIONS**

**(i) Vigilance Enquiries:-**Vigilance Enquiries are ordered by the Government based on complaints received. This Bureau does not conduct any Vigilance Enquiry on its own.

During the year 2014 - 2015 , **157** references were received from Government for conducting Vigilance Enquiry. Out of the total **471** Vigilance Enquiries handled by this Bureau, **191** enquires were completed and reports forwarded to Government. Thus **280** Vigilance Enquiries were pending with this Bureau as on 31.03.2015.

Out of the **157** Vigilance Enquiries ordered by the Government during 2014 - 2015, **14** related to illegal gratification, **34** related to misappropriation, **83** related to various irregularities and **26** related to disproportionate assets.

**(ii) Confidential Verifications:-** Besides Vigilance Enquiries, this Bureau conducts Confidential Verifications also at its own initiative or under Government direction. Confidential Verifications are conducted mainly on the allegation of amassment of wealth by Public Servants through corrupt practices.

During the year 2014 - 2015, **172** Confidential Verifications were ordered. Out of the total **222** Confidential Verifications, **141** were completed and report forwarded to Government. Thus, **81** Confidential Verifications are pending as on 31.03.2015.

Out of **172** Confidential Verifications ordered during the year 2014 - 2015, **27** related to illegal gratification, **9** related to Misappropriations, **60** related to irregularities and **76** related to amassment of assets.

**(iii) Surprise Checks:** - The Vigilance & Anti-Corruption Bureau, at its own initiative, conducts Surprise Checks on receipt of petitions and Source Reports.

During the year, this Bureau had conducted **1189** Surprise Checks including **95** Special Drives in different parts of the State and a total of **1250** Surprise Check Reports were forwarded to Government/ Action dropped.

**(iv) Quick Verifications:-** Government is the proper authority to order a Vigilance Enquiry. But very often Government forward references to this Bureau for examination and report without formally ordering a Vigilance Enquiry. The Courts also forward a number of references for enquiries without strictly ordering Vigilance Enquiry. In such references, action is required to ascertain prima facie the genuineness of the contents of the petition by generally verifying the basic facts. Conducting elaborate Vigilance Enquiries on all Court Endorsed References and Government Endorsed References would only delay the replies to Court/Government for a long time. The time limit prescribed for completion of Quick Verification is 15 days or such time limits as prescribed by Court .

During the year 2014 – 2015, **614** Quick Verifications were ordered. About **374** Quick Verifications were completed and forwarded report to Government /Further Action Dropped. Thus **530** Quick Verifications are pending as on 31.03.2015.

**(v) Vigilance Cases:** - Vigilance & Anti-Corruption Bureau register cases Under the PC Act 1988 on finding prima facie evidence of criminal misconduct by Public Servants, after conducting Vigilance Enquiry/Confidential Verification/Surprise Check/Quick Verification and on receipt of information of demand and acceptance of bribe by Public Servants. Vigilance Cases are registered by the Unit Officers on getting sanction from the Director of the Bureau after assessing the evidence available. In Trap Cases, the Unit Officers are authorised to register Cases Suo-moto.

As on 31.03.2014, a total number of **369** Vigilance Cases were pending with this Bureau. During the year under report, **263** Vigilance Cases (including **29** Trap Cases) were registered. Out of the total **632** Vigilance Cases, investigation was completed and report forwarded to Government in **133** Vigilance Cases. Thus **499** Vigilance Cases are pending with the Bureau as on 31.03.2015.

Out of the **263** Vigilance Cases registered during the year 2014 – 2015, **38** related to illegal gratification, **98** related to misappropriation, **107** related to irregularities and **20** related to disproportionate assets.

The Department-wise break-up of Vigilance Cases registered during the year 2014 – 2015 is given in Appendix – IV .

**(a) Trap Cases:** - During the year 2014 - 2015, **29** Trap Cases were registered by this Bureau on allegation of the demand and acceptance of bribe by Public Servants.

The Department-wise break-up of Trap Cases registered during the year 2014 - 2015 is given in Appendix - V.

### ***5. TRIAL CASES***

There are 4 Special Courts functioning in the State exclusively for the trial of Vigilance Cases charge sheeted by this Bureau with Headquarters at Thiruvananthapuram, Kottayam, Thrissur, and Kozhikkode.

During the year under report, **90** Vigilance Cases were charge sheeted in the Courts. Department wise break up of cases charge sheeted during the year 2014 - 2015 is given in Appendix - IV .

As on 31.03.2015, **42** Vigilance Cases were disposed off by the Courts. Out of this **19** ended in conviction and **23** ended in acquittal and one case was abated. Thus the rate of Conviction is 45%. **1226** Vigilance Cases are pending trial before the Special Courts as on 31.03.2015.

Scope for filing appeal is examined in every case, which ends in acquittal and action is taken to file appeal if found necessary.

### ***6. ENQUIRY BY THE VIGILANCE TRIBUNALS***

There are two Vigilance Tribunals, one at Thiruvananthapuram and the other at Kozhikkode to conduct enquiry in disciplinary

proceedings, warranting the award of major penalties, referred by the Government on the recommendations of this Bureau. The Vigilance Tribunals after completing the enquiry, forward the reports directly to Government with its recommendations for final disposal by Government.

As on 31.03.2014, **53** references were pending for final orders from Government. During the year under report, **6** references were sent to Vigilance Tribunals by the Government. Out of the total **59** references, final orders were received from Government in **8** references. Thus as on 31.03.2015, **83** references are pending at Vigilance Tribunal.

The Department-wise break-up of references referred to Vigilance Tribunals during the year 2014 – 2015 is given in Appendix – VII.

#### **7. DEPARTMENTAL ACTION**

The Vigilance & Anti-Corruption Bureau recommends Departmental Disciplinary Action against Officers where the evidence collected during enquiry/investigation is not sufficient either to order a Tribunal Enquiry or to launch a successful prosecution.

During the year 2014 – 2015, Departmental Disciplinary Proceedings were recommended against **1634** Officers involved in Vigilance Cases, Vigilance Enquiries, Confidential Verifications, Surprise Checks and Quick Verifications.

The department-wise break-up of the Officers against whom Departmental Disciplinary Proceedings were recommended during the year 2014 – 2015 is given in Appendix VIII.

#### **10. MODERNISATION**

#### **11. DISTRICT VIGILANCE COMMITTEE**

District Vigilance Committee was constituted in every District as per G.O.(P)No.11/2013/Vig. dated 25..03..2013. The District Vigilance Committee in each District is under the chairmanship of the

District Collector. The Unit Deputy Superintendent of Police is the Convenor of the Committee. The District Vigilance Committee Meeting is held once in three months. The Committee discuss the complaints with the concerned or with the District Officer and take immediate redressal on such complaints. The District level Officers of certain Government Departments (mentioned in the Government Order) and Office bearers of some social organizations are the members (mentioned in the Government Order) of the Committee. This Committee has started functioning from July, 2013.

## **12. LIGHTNING SQUAD**

The Vigilance Lightning Squad started functioning as per G.O.(MS) No.57/2012/Vig. dated 15.12.2012. The mechanism is implemented for attending the grievances of the public on real time basis. This system is implemented in Thiruvananthapuram City limits only. The Inspector of Police of Vigilance & Anti - Corruption Bureau is the Team Head. On their visit to various Offices if the Inspector of Police feels that it is serious matter having vigilance angle of considerable magnitude he will immediately contact Scrutiny Officer for arranging a Surprise Check through Vigilance Unit Offices. The daily report of the Inspector of Police on their visits are also verified by the Director and necessary actions are also made on this. This system started operation from 22.03.2013.

### **13. E – OFFICE IMPLEMENTATION**

Government vide G.O(Rt) No.130/2014/Vig. dated 02..08..2014 accorded Administrative Sanction for an amount of Rs.20 lakh under the Head of Account 2070 – 00 – 104 – 98 – Modernisation of Vigilance Department (Plan) towards the implementation of e-office in Vigilance & Anti-Corruption Bureau in collaboration with Information Technology Mission (IT Mission). The project is in its preliminary stage.

### **14. CONSTRUCTION OF OFFICE BUILDINGS**

In the current year's Budget allotment, an outlay of Rs.300 lakh is provided for the construction of Office Buildings at Thodupuzha (Idukki) and Palakkad for housing Unit Offices of Vigilance & Anti-Corruption Bureau during the year 2015 – 2016. Government in Vigilance Department was addressed for allotting necessary fund under Public Works Department Head of Account for the construction of Office buildings at Thodupuzha (Idukki) and Palakkad and Administrative Sanction was also requested for the same vide letter No.G2 – 22119/2015 dated 01..07..2015 and letter No.G2 – 21028/2015 dated 29..06..2015 respectively. Also the proposal for the construction of the Unit Office of Vigilance & Anti-Corruption Bureau at Kannur is under consideration of Government.

### **15. INTERNAL AUDIT**

1. There is no staff used exclusively for internal audit. A permanent Internal Audit Wing is not constituted so far. However, a team comprising Accounts Officer, Senior Superintendent, Junior Superintendent and Section Clerks is being conduct the Internal Audit.

2. Internal audit has not been conducted in any of the subordinate Offices in the year 2014 – 2015 and 2015 – 2016 due to the shortage in staff strength and the same has been informed the Government also. Communications are already initiated with Government for increasing the staff strength and an exclusive team will be constituted for Internal Audit upon sanctioning of additional staff.

## **16. CONCLUSION**

During the year 2014 – 2015 the number of pending Vigilance Enquiries was brought down from **314** to **280**. During the year 263 Vigilance Cases were registered and 133 Vigilance Cases were finalized and report sent to Government / submitted to Vigilance Court.. The Surprise Checks especially the Statewide Surprise Checks had deterrent effect.

## **17. GOLDEN JUBILEE CELEBRATIONS**

The Bureau has celebrated its Golden Jubilee during 2013 – 2014. The celebrations were formally inaugurated by the Honourable Chief Minister Shri Oommen Chandy at a grand function on 26.12.2013 at Kanakakkunnu Palace Hall, Thiruvananthapuram. Realising that the role of the public is of paramount importance in

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checking corruption, Seminars, Essay Competitions, Public Awareness Programme are being organized during the Golden Jubilee Year. The celebrations was finalized in December, 2014.

#### **18. VIGILANT KERALA**

Vigilant kerala is a new initiate of Vigilance & Anti-Corruption Bureau, Kerala to prevent and eradicate corruption from our society at the grass root level with mass participation of Bureaucrats, Head of Institutions, Vigilance Officers and General public.

Mission: 100% development funds reach the primary users of the Panchayath without any leakage at any point from the source thereby more sources feel confident to invest/supply funds.

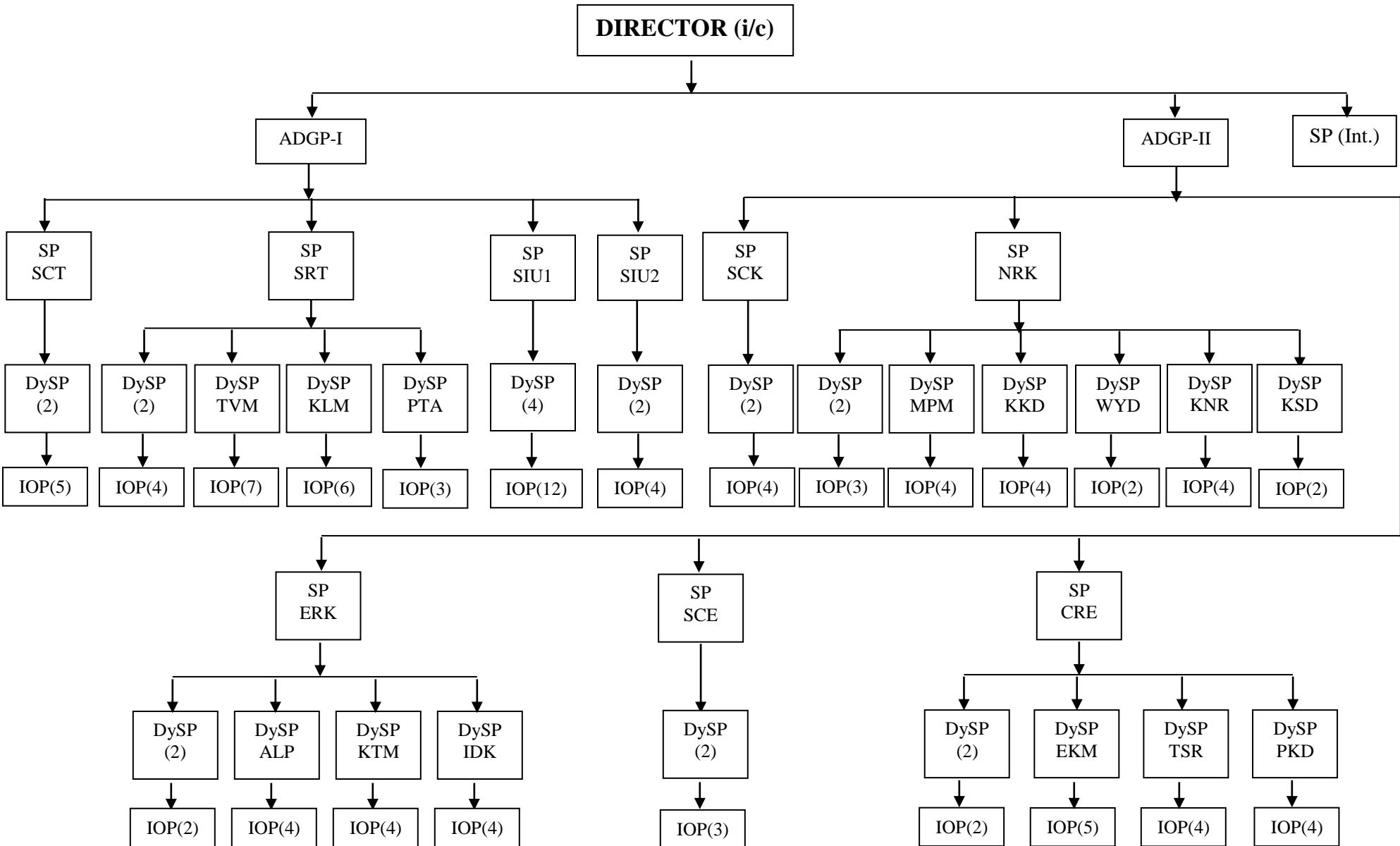

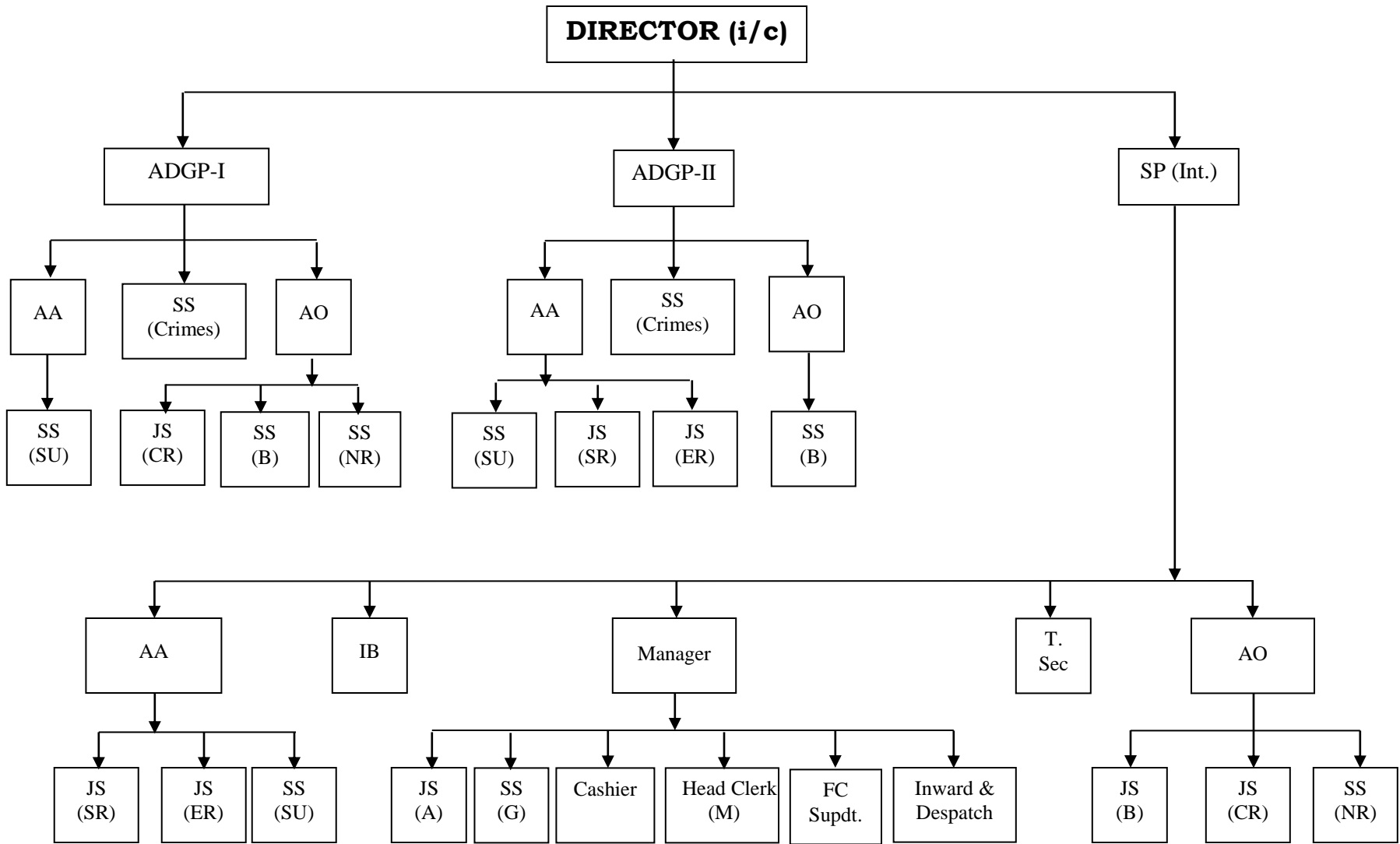
